
Parables on Kingdom of God

David, Psalm 51:5

- Surely I was **sinful at birth**, sinful from the time my mother conceived me.

Jesus, 2 Cor. 5:21

God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.



David confesses his Sin

2 Samuel 12:13 (NLT)

Then David confessed to Nathan,

"I have sinned against the LORD."

Nathan replied,

"Yes, but the LORD has forgiven you, and you won't die for this sin.

1 John 1:8-10

If we claim to be without sin, we deceive ourselves and the truth is not in us. If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness. If we claim we have not sinned, we make him out to be a liar and his word is not in us.

Psalm 130: 3-4


If you, Lord, kept a record of sins, Lord, who could stand? But with you there is forgiveness, so that we can, with reverence, serve you.


Finished obeying the will of the Father

I have finished the race,


I have kept the faith.




